

1 Introduction

Smarten mobile app is a native app for the Smarten Augmented Analytics platform that is available on both Android and iOS platforms. Users can log in to the mobile app using their Smarten credentials and have access to their BI objects as per access rights. Users can also export and share any BI objects, including dashboard and reports.

The Smarten mobile app enables users to access Smarten analytics on the go and from anywhere.

2 How it works

- Smarten Mobile App communicates with the Smarten server using secure web APIs depending upon the configured communication channel, i.e., HTTP or HTTPS protocol. If HTTPS is configured on the Smarten server, the Smarten Mobile App will communicate with the Smarten server on a secure HTTPS channel.
- To access the Smarten Mobile App, the user must log in using a secured ID and password. Mobile app user authentication is based on the authentication method configured on the Smarten server. Authentication methods and user credentials are the same for the Smarten Mobile App and for the Smarten web interface and employ Smarten proprietary default authentication, enterprisewide authentication methods using directory services such as AD and LDAP, and custom authentication using Single sign on (SSO).
- The Smarten Mobile App is secure. It does not store or share the user identity or related data or transfer data to third-party systems. The Smarten Mobile App does not store dashboard or report data on the user's local mobile device or on third-party apps.
- Administrators do not need to separately configure and allow access to Smarten Mobile App users for dashboards, reports, and other Smarten objects. All access rights and privileges defined on the Smarten enterprise server will also be used by the Smarten Mobile App as is, and there is no need to have separate access rights management for Mobile app users to manage BI objects access rights for Mobile app users.

3 Assigning Mobile App access to a user

A user needs to have the required permissions to log in to the Smarten Mobile app. Smarten administrator provides the required permissions to the users.

Note:

Smarten Mobile App access rights are add-on access rights to existing BI users.

Procedure

- 1. Log in to Smarten as an administrator.
- 2. Click Administration from the menu.



4 Installing and Configuring Mobile App

You can download and install the Smarten mobile app from the Google Play store and Apple App Store. After the app is downloaded and installed, you need to log in and configure the app.

Procedure

- 1. Open the Smarten Mobile App.
- Enter the Smarten URL that you want to access.
 You must enter the fully qualified URL of the Smarten server of your organisation. The Smarten server must be accessible through the internet from your mobile device. For example, 'https://bi.yourcompany.com/smarten'.

- 3. Tap Submit.
- 4. Enter your login credentials, and tap **Sign In**. You can use the same credentials that you use to access the web interface of Smarten.



5 Smarten Mobile App user interface

This section provides Smarten mobile app user interface overview.

5.1 Overall navigation



SMARTEN MOBILE APP-INTERFACE

Element	Description
1	Menu contains options to navigate to the home screen, browse objects, configure Smarten URL, about Smarten mobile app, and sign out.
2	Recent, My Favourites, and Browse tabs allow you to browse objects.
3	The search option allows you to access the NLP search (Clickless analytics) feature.
4	The home button displays the object that you have marked as home. If home page is not set, then it will show the Browse objects page.
5	The refresh button refreshes the current screen.

5.2 Browse objects

The Smarten mobile app provides many ways to browse objects. Users can use any of the following options to browse an object:

- Recent—Displays the objects you have recently viewed
- My Favourites—Displays a list of objects that you have marked as favourite
- Browse—Displays the Smarten repository that allows you to browse for an object from the entire repository

5.2.1 Recent Tab

The **Recent** tab displays the objects that you have viewed recently.



You can also search for an object by its name within the tab.

5.3 Clickless Search option

The Clickless search option on the landing screen allows you to search for particular data based on Natural Language Processing (NLP) queries.



5.4 Home

6 Viewing Smarten objects


You can tap on an object to view that object. Once the object is opened, you can perform various operations on that object.

Note:

Some of the operations and interactions available on the Smarten Web Application may not be available in the Mobile app. In the mobile app, Export and Share features are available based on the Export

permissions given to the user on a particular object.

6.1 Viewing Dashboard objects



You can perform the following operations on the dashboard object in the Smarten mobile app:

- Filter: Use this option to filter the data that is used by the object.
- **Export:** Use this option to export the object as JPG, PNG, PDF, XLS, and XLSX on the mobile device.
- **Share:** Use this option to share the object through another mobile application.
- Information: Use this option to view information about the object.
- Ellipsis menu:
 - **Mark as Home:** Use this option to display the home page with the object that is marked as home.
 - Mark as Favourite: Use this option to display the list of objects that are marked as favourites. If an object is already marked as favourite, the Remove from Favourite option is displayed for the object.
- Zoom button: Use this option to zoom the dashboard object and display it in full screen.
- **Show/Hide legends:** Use this option to display or hide the legends of a dashboard. In some cases, a few of the legends of a dashboard are displayed. In such cases, you can use this option to view all the legends.

- Share: Use this option to share the object through another mobile application.
- **Export:** Use this option to export the object as JPG, PNG, PDF, XLS, and XLSX on the mobile device.
- Information: Use this option to view information about the object.
- Ellipsis menu:
 - **Mark as Home:** Use this option to display the home page with the object that is marked as home.
 - Mark as Favourite: Use this option to display the list of objects that are marked as favourites. If an object is already marked as favourite, the Remove from Favourite option is displayed for the object.
- Left: Use this option to view the columns on the left.
- Right: Use this option to view the columns on the right.
- **Up:** Use this option to view the rows at the top.
- **Down:** Use this option to view the rows at the bottom.





- Ellipsis menu:
 - **Mark as Home:** Use this option to display the home page with the object that is marked as home.
 - Mark as Favourite: Use this option to display the list of objects that are marked as favourites. If an object is already marked as favourite, the **Remove from Favourite** option is displayed for the object.
- Show/Hide legends: Use this option to display or hide the legends of a dashboard. In some cases, a few of the legends of a dashboard are displayed. In such cases, you can use this option to view all the legends.




You can perform the following operations on the SmartenView object in the Smarten mobile app:

- Show all values: Use this option to show all values in the SmartenView object.



- KPI View: Use this option to change the KPI view of the object.
- Frequency: Use this option to change how often you want to measure the KPI.
- Share: Use this option to share the object through another mobile application.
- **Export:** Use this option to export the object as JPG, PNG, PDF, XLS, and XLSX on the mobile device.
- Information: Use this option to view information about the object.
- Ellipsis menu:



- Share: Use this option to share the object through another mobile application.
- **Export:** Use this option to export the object as JPG, PNG, PDF, XLS, and XLSX on the mobile device.
- Information: Use this option to view information about the object.
- Ellipsis menu:
 - **Mark as Home:** Use this option to display the home page with the object that is marked as home.
 - Mark as Favourite: Use this option to display the list of objects that are marked as favourites. If an object is already marked as favourite, the Remove from Favourite option is displayed for the object.
- **Plus:** Use this option to zoom in on the object.
- Minus: Use this option to zoom out on the object.
- Home: Use this option to resize the object to its original size.



6.9 Viewing Print Report objects

You can perform the following operations on the print report object in the Smarten mobile app:


- Filter: Use this option to filter the data that is used by the object.
- **Export:** Use this option to export the object as JPG, PNG, PDF, XLS, and XLSX on the mobile device.
- Share: Use this option to share the object through another mobile application.
- Information: Use this option to view information about the object.
- Ellipsis menu:
 - **Mark as Home:** Use this option to display the home page with the object that is marked as home.
 - Mark as Favourite: Use this option to display the list of objects that are marked as favourites. If an object is already marked as favourite, the Remove from Favourite option is displayed for the object.
- Next: Use this option to view the next page of the report.
- **Previous:** Use this option to view the previous page of the report.
- First: Use this option to view the first page of the report.
- Last: Use this option to view the last page of the report.

6.10 Marking an Object as Favourite

You can mark many objects as favourites, and all these objects are listed in the **My Favourites** tab for quick access.

Procedure:

- 1. Open the object that you want to mark as favourite.
- 2. Select Mark as Favourite from the menu.



If an object is already marked as favourite, the **Remove from Favourite** option is displayed for the object.


6.11 Marking an Object as Home

The home button displays an object only if you have marked an object as home. If no object is marked as home, an error message is displayed.

Note: You can mark only one object as home. The last object you have marked as home is displayed on the home page.

Procedure:

- 1. Open the object that you want to mark as home.
- 2. Select Mark as Home from the menu.



The object is marked as home and will be displayed the next time you click the home button.
